Code of Conduct

Adopted October 2022

As a member or visitor of Lybster Golf Club you are expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct:

- If you have a golf handicap/SGU membership, abide by the Scottish Golf Union Code of Conduct Policy.
- Help create and maintain an environment free of fear and harassment.
- Demonstrate fair play and apply golf's rules and standards both on and off the course.
- Treat others as you would wish to be treated yourself.
- Respect physical, cultural and racial difference.
- Treat organisers, officials, golf club members with respect. Without them you would not be able to enjoy golf as much.
- If you borrow or use any club equipment, or receive any club trophies, look after and return it when requested or if you leave the club, in a good order, or accept consequences of ensuring its replacement.
- Members must pay any fees for membership and events promptly.
- Pay attention at all times to what is going on around you.
- You should not take part in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour, which could include, but not limited to; illegal or performance enhancing drugs or stimulants, foul language.
- You should not publicly use critical or disrespectful descriptions of others, Lybster GC or other clubs.
- Use appropriate language especially in the vicinity of young people, members or public.
- Rules apply in golf like other sports; they are there to provide structure, balanced competition and safety. Learn to understand them and stick to them. Ask for clarification when needed.
- Treat all other golfers as you would like to be treated. Don't bully or take unfair advantage of anyone, this will not be tolerated.
- Always be willing to help set up equipment, officiate, keep the club house tidy. Golf is not all about competing.
- If you have concerns regarding other members, officials behaviour, then please contact the Club Captain, who will discuss matters with you and take any necessary appropriate action according to the clubs policy.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Have fun.
