The above picture clarifies who is responsible for different sections of the Scorecard.

After each hole during the round, the marker should confirm with the player the number of strokes on that hole. They should then sign the card at the end to certify the card.

During the round, the player should keep track of their scores for each hole. When the round has ended, the player should carefully check the hole scores entered by the marker and sign to certify the card.

The Competitions Secretaries are responsible for checking that cards are completed correctly and accurately before publishing the results.
